- Diagnosed with a Mental Health Condition
- Tennessee Resident
- Ages 3-17
- US Citizen or Qualified Legal Alien
- No Income Limit
- Not in an Inpatient Facility or Foster Care
- Ineligible for TennCare
- Insured Children or Children with CoverKids
May Receive the Following Services if They Meet Other BHSN Eligibility Criteria:

Case Management
Family Support Services
Family Therapy
Medication Training and Support
Transportation to and from BHSN Services
