


KEY OBSERVATIONS


Source data: The TOMIS data extracted for this fact sheet provides a "snapshot" of the juvenile population of TDOC felons in state prisons and local jails June 2003.


The typical juvenile inmate under TDOC supervision is a single **17 year old Black male** who has been convicted of **Aggravated Robbery** in **Davidson or Shelby County** and is serving approximately **8.4 years** in **NWCX** prison.





- The age range of juveniles under TDOC custody = 16 17 years
- Average age of juvenile offenders under TDOC custody = 17 years
- Most common offense = Aggravated Robbery
- The sentences of the juveniles range from to 3 to 25 years
- Average sentence length = 8.4 years
- Most common counties of conviction = Davidson (29%) and Shelby (21%)
- Marital status = Single (100%)
- Sex = Male (93%), Female (7%)
- Race = Black (76%), White (20%), Hispanic (4%)
