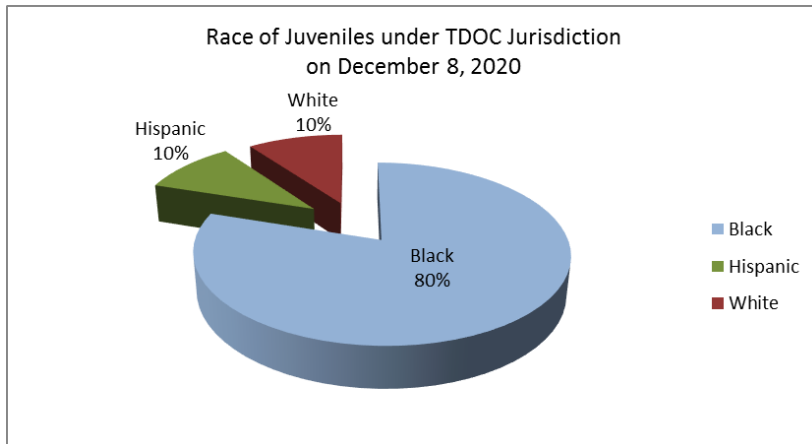


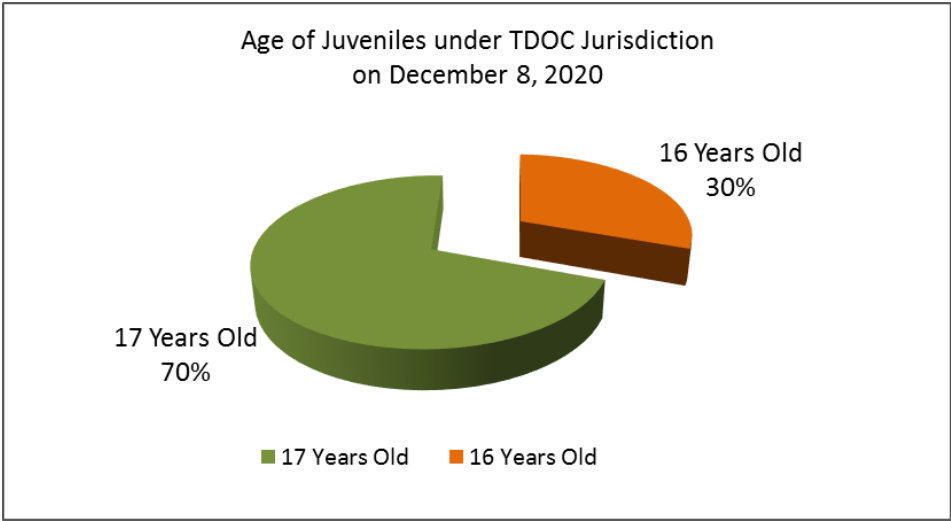
FACT SHEET: Juveniles (Under 18 years old) under Tennessee Department of Correction Jurisdiction on December 8, 2020

The data used for this fact sheet has been extracted from the Tennessee Offender Management Information System (TOMIS) and summarized by Decision Support: Research & Planning of the Tennessee Department of Correction.

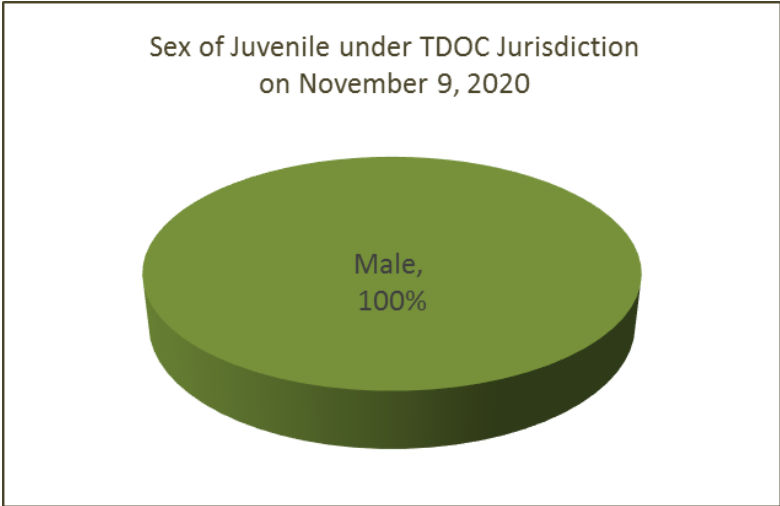
- Ten (10) juveniles were under TDOC jurisdiction on December 8, 2020.
- Six (6) juveniles were at the Northwest Correctional Complex in Tiptonville, TN, one (1) juvenile was at West Madison County Jail, one (1) juvenile was at the Davidson County Jail, one (1) juvenile was at the Shelby County Jail, and one (1) juvenile was at the Sumner County Jail.
- Seven (7) juveniles were 17 years old and three (3) juveniles were 16 years old.
- Primary Offense categories were Aggravated Robbery (4), Attempted Homicide (1), Homicide (1), Aggravated Assault (1) and Not Available for three (3) juveniles.
- Sentence range was 5 to 19.5 years for seven (7) juveniles and Not Available for three (3) juveniles.
- Eight (8) juveniles were Black/African American, one (1) juvenile was Hispanic and one (1) juvenile was White.
- All ten (10) juveniles were Male.

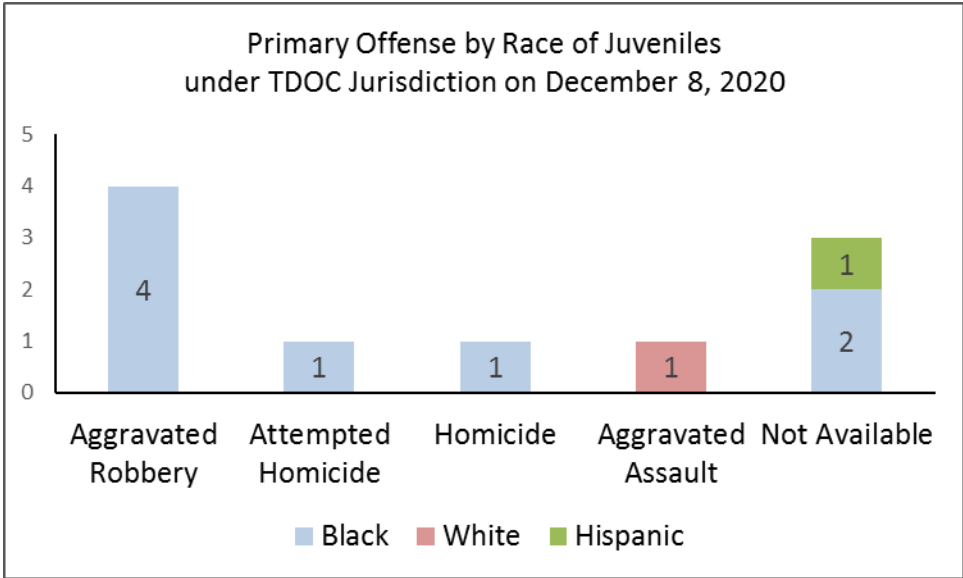
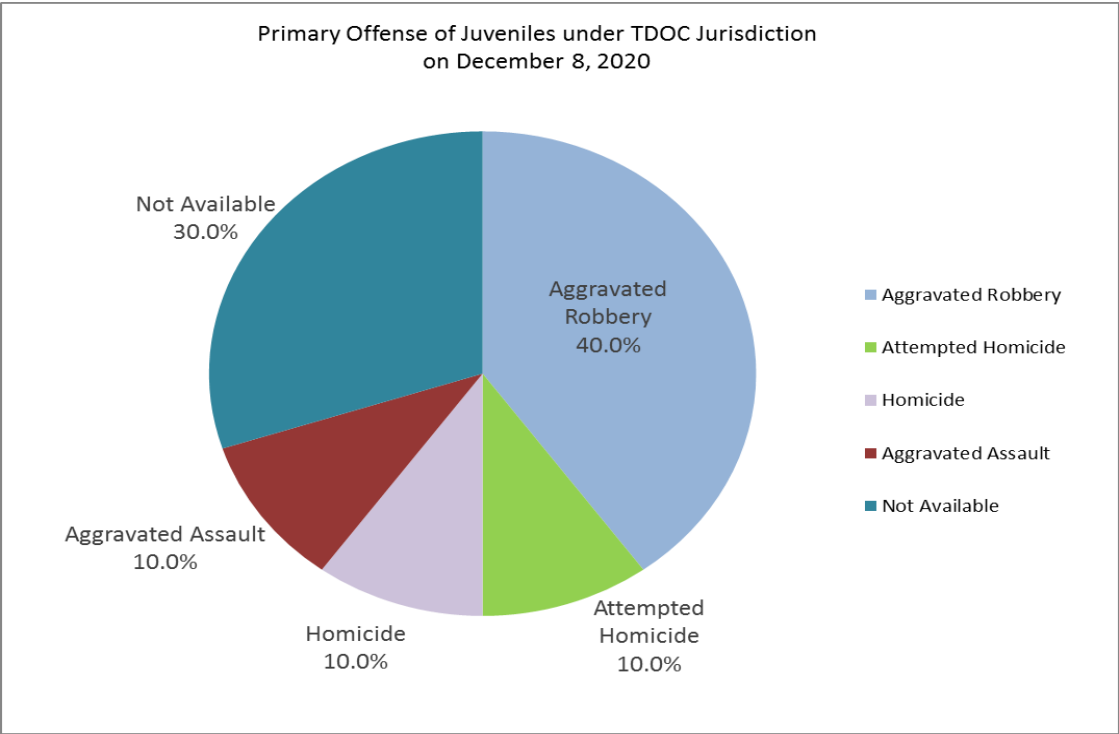

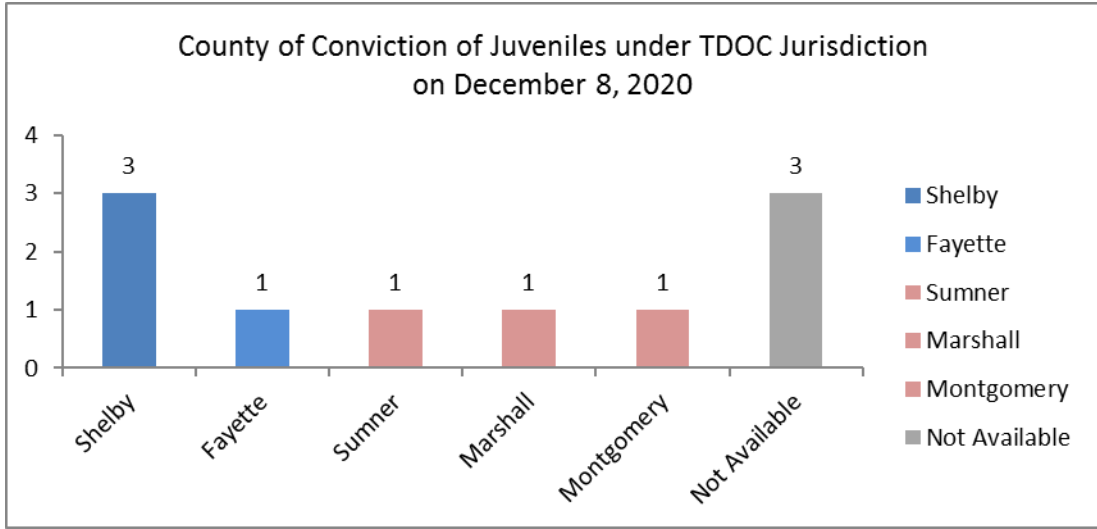
