

## FACT SHEET: Juveniles (Under 18 years old) under Tennessee Department of Correction Jurisdiction on July 10, 2018

The data used for this fact sheet has been extracted from the Tennessee Offender Management Information System (TOMIS) and summarized by Decision Support: Research & Planning of the Tennessee Department of Correction.


- ▶ Thirteen (13) juveniles were under TDOC jurisdiction on July 10, 2018.
- Ten (10) juveniles were at the Northwest Correctional Complex in Tiptonville, TN, one (1) was at the Sumner County Jail, one (1) was at the Madison County Jail and one (1) was at the Shelby County Criminal Justice Center.
- Eleven (11) juveniles were 17 years old and two (2) juveniles were 16 years old.
- Primary Offense categories were Aggravated Robbery (7), Robbery (1), Homicide (1), and Theft (1). Primary Offense category was not available for three (3) juveniles.
- Sentence range for the juveniles was 6 to 25 years for ten (10) juveniles. Sentence Range was not available for three (3) juveniles.
- Twelve (12) juveniles were Black/African American and one (1) juvenile was White.
- ➤ All thirteen (13) juveniles were Male.






