

FACT SHEET: Juveniles (Under 18 years old) under Tennessee Department of Correction Jurisdiction on July 9, 2020

The data used for this fact sheet has been extracted from the Tennessee Offender Management Information System (TOMIS) and summarized by Decision Support: Research & Planning of the Tennessee Department of Correction.


- Six (6) juveniles were under TDOC jurisdiction on July 9, 2020.
- Four (4) juveniles were at the Northwest Correctional Complex in Tiptonville, TN, one (1) juvenile was at the West Madison County Jail, and one (1) juvenile was at the Montgomery County Jail.
- Five (5) juveniles were 17 years old and one (1) juvenile was 16 years old.
- Primary Offense categories were Aggravated Robbery (3), Attempted Homicide (2) and Aggravated Assault (1).
- Sentence range was 5 to 15 years for the six (6) juveniles.
- Five (5) juveniles were Black/African American and one (1) juvenile was White.
- ➢ All Six (6) juveniles were Male.


