

## **FACT SHEET: Juveniles (Under 18 years old) under Tennessee Department of Correction Jurisdiction on September 9, 2020**


The data used for this fact sheet has been extracted from the Tennessee Offender Management Information System (TOMIS) and summarized by Decision Support: Research & Planning of the Tennessee Department of Correction.


- ▶ Four (4) juveniles were under TDOC jurisdiction on September 9, 2020.
- Two (2) juveniles were at the Northwest Correctional Complex in Tiptonville, TN, one (1) juvenile was at the West Madison County Jail, and one (1) juvenile was at the Mid-Montgomery County Jail.
- Three (3) juveniles were 17 years old and one (1) juvenile was 16 years old.
- Primary Offense categories were Aggravated Robbery (2), Attempted Homicide (1) and Aggravated Assault (1).
- Sentence range was 5 to 12 years for the four (4) juveniles.
- Three (3) juveniles were Black/African American and one (1) juvenile was White.
- ➢ All four (4) juveniles were Male.


