

INFORMATION

Wheelchair Hunters Waterfowl Blind

Waterfowl Blinds #RWC1, #RWC2 and #RWC3 on Reelfoot Lake Wildlife Management Area are reserved for wheelchair-bound hunters during the Reelfoot (state) duck season. Wheelchair-bound hunters are defined as persons who are totally and permanently confined to a wheelchair as certified by a physician. Persons interested in reserving one of those blinds for a portion of the upcoming duck season must obtain a "Use Permit" from the Agency by submitting the attached application as instructed below.

A hand-held drawing will be conducted on October 26, 2018, to determine successful applicants. Persons who were issued a permit for a waterfowl blind on the first Saturday in August on any management area are not eligible to participate. Hunters selected will have full authority to occupy and hunt from the blind during the days of the hunt period assigned. Hunters selected must be accompanied by a minimum of one hunting assistant, but no more than three hunting assistants (at least one assistant must be age 16 or older). Hunters must have appropriate statewide licenses and the correct Reelfoot

Preservation permit and must abide by all the rules and regulations that apply to hunting on Reelfoot Lake WMA.

These blinds were designed to provide wheelchair-bound hunters ease in accessibility and hunting.

How to Apply

- 1. Only one (1) application may be submitted per person, per area. No fee is required to apply.
- 2. Submit attached "Application" with information requested to the Jackson Region I office either by mail or hand delivered no later than noon C.D.T. October 24, 2019.
- 3. On the application, select the hunting period by priority. Example: If your first hunting period preference is "Dec. 1-7," mark a <u># 1</u> in the space adjacent to that period. Mark a <u># 2</u>, in the space adjacent to your second preference, etc. Applicants may select all ten hunting periods, marking the priority hunts from #1 to #10. Ten should be your lowest priority.
